Antonella, a fifty years old woman, loses her staff job and his husband, and finds out she has breast cancer. She gets a job as a caretaker for an old widowed woman with Alzeheimer's: Marilosa, Antonella finds in Marilosa's house a letter written by a young antifascist university student who was in jail during World War II. Antonella also finds some notes written by Marilosa, which tell about the love story between Marilosa and that young student. Therefore, alongside her friend, she decides to try to find that man, assuming he's still alive. She does so in order to distract herself from her disease and from the therapy's side effects. New feelings arise in her, directed to the doctor that treats her and later to Marilosa's son. The suspicion is that that young lover is actually the real father of Giovanni, Marilosa's son, who is officially the son of Marilosa's husband. Giovanni becomes the protagonist in the final stages of the story, set in Paris. He has the chance to find out who his real father is, but he postpones the decision to read the letter that could possibly reveal the truth. An intense novel of miysteries and passions.
